PROPERTY TAXES DUE JULY 4TH

REMINDER – It's time to pay your Property Taxes and claim your Home Owners Grant by 4:00 p.m. on July 4, 2016. On July 5th a 10% penalty will be applied to all outstanding property taxes and unclaimed Home Owners Grants.

You can claim the grant without making a payment. You may claim your grant in four ways:

- > Online by visiting www.chasebc.ca (use the folio number and PIN # noted on your tax notice)
- > By mail: detach the application form at the bottom of your tax notice--fill it in and mail it to us
- > Visit Chase Village Office at 826 Okanagan Ave open 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday to Friday
- > Complete the form and drop it in drop-box located at the main entrance of the office 24/7

TAX DEFERMENT PROGRAM

The Property Tax Deferment Program is a low-interest Provincial loan program designed to help qualified BC home owners pay their annual property taxes. There are two programs you may qualify for: the Regular Program and the Families with Children Program. For further information and to find out if you are eligible, visit www.gov.bc.ca and search for "Tax Deferment Program". If you are eligible, please submit the following to the Village Office by the July 4th tax due date: any arrears and penalties you owe, your home owner grant application, and your tax deferment application.

BUSINESS LICENCES

Chase residents are reminded to ensure that, when hiring a company or individual either from Chase or not, they are required to hold a valid Village of Chase Business License.

Businesses with storefronts are required to have business licenses to ensure that they conform to zoning and safety measures that are in place for their patrons. To ensure a level playing field for all businesses, contractors and tradespeople without storefronts are also required to hold a valid business license.
