Garbage - Recycle Collection *Help us serve you better!*

- Friday March 30th service as usual.
- Containers must be placed curbside by 7:00 am on collection day.
- Container lids must be completely closed for pickup.
- Containers must be away from obstructions (parked cars, trees etc....)
- **PARK IT** – wheels against curb, or just off the roadway.
- **POINT IT** – arrows should point to centre of road.
- **SPACE IT** – give at least an arm's length distance between containers.

Business Licenses – 2018 business licenses are required for anyone receiving money for a good or service including home-based businesses.

Dog Licenses – 2018 dog licenses are available for purchase at the Village office. Our *Dog Control Bylaw* requires all dogs over 4-months old to be licensed, and renewals must be complete by March 1st of each year or you could be subject to a fine! The fine for an unlicensed dog is \$75.00.

Water Billing - If you have any questions regarding your water consumption invoice, please contact our office at 250-679-3238 – if there are water leaks contributing to higher water costs for you, we may be able to detect those leaks and ensure you have them fixed to reduce your water costs.
