

VILLAGE OF CHASE

BY-LAW NO. 41

A by-law to provide for the Assessment Roll of the Village of Chase and to determine the basis of assessment.

The Council of the Village of Chase ENACT AS

FOLLOWS:

1. In this by-law "parcel" means any lot, block, or other area in which land is held or into which land is subdivided and includes any two of the aforementioned with an area of $\frac{1}{4}$ acre or less used as one holding.

2. That Mrs. G. Danks is appointed Assessor and Collector of the Village.

3. That the said Mrs G. Danks is directed to make the Assessment Roll of the Village.

4. That the basis of assessment shall be parcels of land.

5. That the assessor shall classify the parcels of land in the Village into groups as follows:

GROUP A shall comprise each and every parcel of land with an area of $\frac{1}{4}$ acre or less to which water can be supplied from the works of the Village.

GROUP B shall comprise each and every parcel of land with an area of 2 acres or less but more than $\frac{1}{4}$ acre to which water can be supplied from the works of the Village.

GROUP C shall comprise each and every parcel of land with an area of 10 acres or less but more than 2 acres to which water can be supplied from the works of the Village.

GROUP D shall comprise each and every parcel of land with an area of 26 acres or less but more than 10 acres to which water can be supplied from the works of the Village.

GROUP E shall comprise each and every parcel of land with an area of over 26 acres to which water can be supplied from the works of the Village.

GROUP F shall comprise each and every parcel of land not included within Groups A to E, inclusive.

6. That the Assessor is directed to return the said assessment roll to the Council on or before the _____ day of _____, 1969.

7. This by-law may be cited as the "First Assessment By-law," and shall supercede all previous Assessment By-laws.
