THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF CHASE.

By-law No. 12.

A By law of the Corporation of the Village of Chase with respect to the licensing of business selling liquor within the Village.

WHEREAS it is provided in Section 434 (1) (a) of the Municipal Act, Chapter 255, R.S.B.C. 1960 and Amendments thereto that the Council may tax everyperson and possessor of a license issued persuant to the Government Liquor Act and operating a business of a dining-lounge, dining room, lounge, or public house, or a combination of any of them, in an amount not exceeding twenty percentum (20%) of the amount of the annual license fee or license fees, which was or were required to be paid to the Liquor Control Board in the preceding year in respect of the business.

AND WHEREAS it is further provided by Section 434 (1) (a) of the said Municipal Act that every such person shall, on or before the thirty first day of January in each year, file with the Assessor or Collector or License Collector of the Village a statement showing the amount of the annual license fee of the preceding year which such person was required to pay to the Liquor Control Board.

AND WHEREAS it is provided by Section 434 (1) (a) of the said Municipal Act that the Council may provide for the collecting of such tax, and for imposing penalties similar to those set forth in Secion 456 in default of payment thereof at the time or times appointed and for failure to file the statement required under Section 434 (1) (a) of the Municipal Act.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to impose the said tax as provided in Section 434 (1)(a) and (b) of the Municipal Act.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Chase, in open meetin assembled, enact as follows:-

- l. Every person who is the possessor of a license issued pursuant to the Government Liquor Act and operating a business of a dining room, dining-lounge, or public house as defined by the Government Liquor Act or a combination of any of them, within the Village of Chase shall pay to the Village of Chase an annual tax in the amount of Tempera per centum (10%) of the amount of the annual license fee or license fees which such person was required to pay to the Liquor Control Board in the year preceding the year in which the tax is levied.
- 2. Every such person described in Clause 1 of the By-law shall on or before the 31st day of January in each year, commencing on the 31st day of January, 1970, file with the Assessor or Collector or License collector for the Village of Chase, a statement showing the amount of the annual license fee or fees which such person was requires to pay to the Liquor Control Board in the year preceding the year in which the tax is levied.
- 3. Every person described in Clause 1 of this By-law shall pay the tax refered to in Clause 1 of this By-law within thirty (30) days from the date of any notification to them from the Village that such tax is due.
- 4. Every person who violates the provisions of this By-law shall be liable under Summary Conviction to a penalty not exceeding \$250.00 for every such violation of this By-law, together with the amount of tax payable by such person under the provisions of this By-law, which said penalty and amount of tax shall for the purposes of recovery under this By-law be held to be one penalty.

5. This By-law may be cited as "Liquor License By-law, 1969".
