THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF CHASE.

By-law No. 13.

A By-law respecting licenses for carrying on business within the Village of Chase and for fixing the fees for such licenses.

The Council of the Village of Chase, in open meeting assembled, enect as follows:-

1.

For the purposes of this By-law, unless the context otherwise requires: "Act" means the Municipal Act, being Chapter 255 of the Revised Systemeters of British Columbia, 1960, as amended.

"Business" means the carrying on of a commercial or industrial undertaking of any kind or nature or the providing of professional, personal, or other services for the purpose of gain or profit.

"Resident Business" means a business carried on in or from premises within the Village of Chase.

"Non-Resident Business" means a business, other then a resident business, carried on within the Village of Chase, or with respect to which any work or service is performed within the Village of Chase.

"License Inspector" means the person from time to time duly appointed a License Inspector for the Village of Chase and also any person lawfully acting in that capacity.

- 2. Subject to Section 441 of the Act, no person shall carry on, within the Village of Chase, any business inless he is the holder of a valid and subsisting license issued to him under this By-;aw by the License Inspector, and shall pay in advance therefore to the License Inspector, the sum specified in Schedule "A" attached hereto and made part of this By-law and it shall be incumbent upon each person to renew such license prior to the beginning of each license period as long as such business is being carried on.
- 3. The License Inspector shall have power to grant, issue or transfere licenses as hereinafter provided and subject to the provisions of Section 458 of the Act.
- 4. The application for a license for the first time shall be in the form of Schedule "B" attached hereto and made part of this By-law and shall be signed by the owner of the business or his duly authorized agent, provided that in the case of a partnership or multiple owners any one of the owners or partners may apply and each such owner or partner applying shall be deemed to be the duly authorized agent for all owners or partners.
- 5. (1) The application form shall be delivered to the License Inspector and shall be accompanied by the fee prescribed in Schedule "A".

(2) Where the applicant for licenses is one and the same person as many applications of the same kind as may be coneniently made on the form prescribed may be combined on one such form with out the necessity for the completion of separate application forms for each business for which a license is sought.

(3) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2) but not inconsistant with the Act or this By-law, the License Inspector is hereby authorized to modify the form prescribed, or any of the administrative procedures prescribed, deemed necessary by him when dealing with any owner applying for licenses for more then one bisiness,

6. All fees collected by the License Imspector under this By-law shall be paid forthwith to the Tresurer of the Village of

Chase who shall deal with the said fees in the manner provided in the Act.

7. (1) Except as hereinafter provided, licenses shall be issued so as to terminate on the 3oth day of April and the 31st day of October and no proportionate reduction shall be made on account of any person commencing business or ceasing to do business at any particular time.

(2) Subject to Section 457B of the Act the period for a license with respect to a circus, exhibition or other itinerant show or entertainment, when held elsewhere then in a licensed theater or other licensed place, shall be one day.

8. (1) Evert license granted pursuant to this By-law shall be in the form of Schedule "C" attached hereto and forming part of this By-Law.

(2) No person shall carry on business at two or more premises at the same time under one license.

(3) No person shall change his place of business without first obtaining a transfereof his license in respect thereto and the particulars of such transfer shall be endorsed on the License and the fee for such transfer shall be Two (\$2.00) dollars.

- 9. The License Imspector shall have power to suspend the license, subject to the provisions of Section 453 of the Act.
- 10. Every Licensee under this By-law shall permit reasonable access to the License Inspector to the premises at which the licensed business is being carried on, for the purpose of ensuring that the requirements of this By-law and Division (1) of Part X of the Act are being fulfilled.
- 11. Every person who offends against any of the provisions of this By-law, or who suffers or permits any act or thing to be done in contravention or violation of any of the provisions of this By-lae or neglects to do or refrains from doing anything to be done by this By-law, or who does any act or thing which violates any of the provisions of this By-law shall be deemed to have committed an offense under this By-law and shall be liable on conviction, to a fine or penalty of not less then \$25.00 or more then \$500.00.

12. This By-law may be cited as "Business License By-law, 1969".
