VILLAGE OF CHASE

HI-LAW NO. 32

A By-law to establish conditions for the extension of water utility services.

The Council of the Village of Chase, in open meeting assembled

ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. Where an application for a water connection has been made and the connection cannot be provided unless a water main is extended, such extension shall be made on the following conditions:

(a) In the case of a new subdivision developed within the municipality the subdivider shall be bound by the conditions for extending as laid down in Schedule "D" of the "Village of Chase Subdivision By-law No. 15, 1970", or amendments thereto.

(b) Except as provided in clause (a), at the expense of the applicant for all the costs of the extension, provided that there shall be rebated to the applicant from each subsequent water connection made from such extension within a five year period, an amount equal to the quotient of the front footage of the subsequent connection and the number of feet paid for by the original applicant, which rebate or rebates shall not either singly nor in aggregate exceed the amount expended by the applicant.

2. Every extension and every distribution main and all other work carried out under this by-law shall be of standard satisfactory to the Village and shall be under the supervision of the Village Engineer, and due notice shall be given to the Village Clerk before any work in connection with extending such water main is commenced.

3. This by-law may be cited as "Chase Water Main Extension By-law No. 32, 1970".
