

THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF CHASE.

BY/LAW No. 34.

A By-law of the Village of Chase to amend License By-law No. 13, to permit charging an annual license fee.

The Council of the Village of Chase, in open meeting assembled, enact as follows:

1. By-law No. 13, "Business License By-law, 1969" is hereby amended by making the following additions after Section 7 of the said By-law.
 - 1A (1) Notwithstanding Section 7(1) of this By-law, permanent businesses may be issued a license for the period from January 1 to December 31.
 - (2) The license fee for the annual license shall be double the fee imposed for the same category for a six month period, as shown in Schedule "A" of By-law 13.
 - (3) Provided that the annual license fee prescribed may be reduced by one half with respect of a person who becomes liable to be licensed after the thirty first day of July in any one year.
 - (4) In the first year in which the provisions of this By-law are in effect a refund on a pro rata basis may be made in respect of any license the term of which has not expired.
2. This By-law shall take effect on January 1st, 1970.
3. This By-law may be cited as "Business License Amending By-law No. 34, 1970".
