

VILLAGE OF CHASE.

By-Law No. 39.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 328 of the "Municipal Act" Chapter 255, R.S.B.C., 1960, and amendments thereto, that the Council may, by By-law exempt from taxation any lands and improvements therein specified;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Chase deems it necessary and expedient to exempt from taxation part of the taxable assessed value of the lands and improvements owned by the "Chase and District Lions Community Club" located on the hereinafter described property;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Chase, in open meeting assembled, by affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of all the members thereof ENACT AS FOLLOWS;

1. The Village of Chase is hereby authorized to exempt from taxation for the year of 1971 only, 75% of the taxable assessed value of the land and the whole of the taxable assessed value of the new curling rink building which may be assessed in 1971, owned and used exclusively by the "Chase and District Lions Community Club", located in the Village of Chase, Province of British Columbia, and more particularly known and described as Lot B of Plan 19733, D.L. 517, K.D.Y.D.
2. This By-law may be cited as the "Chase and District Lions Community Club Tax Exemption By-law, 1971".
