VILLAGE OF CHASE.

By-Law No. 39.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 328 of the "Municipal Act" Chapter 255, R.S.B.C, 1960, and amendments therete, that the Council may, by By-law exempt from taxation any lands and imprevements therein specified;

AND MHEREAS the Council of the Village of Chase dooms it necessary and expedient to exempt from taxation partical the taxable assessed value of the lands and imprevements ewned by the "Chase and District Liens Community Club" located en the hereinafter described preperty;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Chase, in open meeting assembled, by affirmative vete of at least twethirds of all the members thereof ENACT AS FOLLOWS;

- 1. The Village of Chase is hereby authorized to exempt from taxation for the year of 1971 only, 75% of the taxable assessed value of the land and the whole of the taxable assessed value of the new curling rink building which may be assessed in 1971, ewned and used exclusively by the "Chase and District Liens Semmunity Club", lecated in the Village of Chase, Prevince of British Columbia, and more particularily known and described as Let B of Plan 19733, D.L. 517, K.D.Y.D.
- 2. This By-law may be eited as the "Chase and District Liens Community Club Tax Exemption By-law, 1971".
