

VILLAGE OF CHASE

BY-LAW NO. 56

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 328 of the "Municipal Act " Chapter 255, R.S.B.C. 1960, and amendments thereto, that the Council may by by-law, exempt from taxation any lands and improvements as therein specified;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Chase deems it necessary and expedient to exempt from taxation the whole of the taxable assessed value of land and improvements owned by the "Chase Women's Institute" located on the hereinafter described property;

AND THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Chase by affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of all the members thereof ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Village of Chase is hereby authorized to exempt from taxation for the year of 1972 only, the whole of the taxable assessed value of the land and improvements owned and used exclusively by the "Chase Women's Institute" of Chase, British Columbia, located in the Village of Chase, Province of British Columbia, and more particularly known and described as Lots Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), and Ten (10), D. L. 517, K.D.Y.D., Plan Three Thousand, Five Hundred and Thirty-two (3532).

2. This by-law may be cited as the "Chase Women's Institute 1972 Tax Exemption By-law No. 56".
