

VILLAGE OF CHASE

BY-LAW NO. 60

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGING OF  
FIREARMS.

WHEREAS under Section 871 of the Municipal Act (R.S.B.C. 1960) the Village Council is empowered to regulate or prohibit the discharging of firearms, including air guns, air rifles, air pistols and spring guns:

AND WHEREAS the Village Council deems it necessary and expedient to prohibit the discharging of firearms:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Chase in open meeting assembled, enact as follows:

1. No person may discharge firearms, including air guns, air rifles, air pistols and spring guns within, over or into the boundaries of the Village of Chase.
2. Notwithstanding Section 1, Council may issue a permit for the discharge of firearms for a specific purpose which the Council deems necessary.
3. This By-law shall take effect from the date of registration in the office of the Inspector of Municipalities.
4. This By-law may be cited as the "Prohibiting of the Discharge of Firearms By-law No. 60, 1972".
