VILLAGE OF CHASE

BY_LAW NO. 70

A By-law of the Village of Chase to change the zoning classification of Lot B Plan 2840, D.L. 517, except Plans 8376, 9836, 10368, 12639, 16029, 16303 and 17489, from Al Rural to Rl Residential.

The Council of the Village of Chase, in open meeting assembled enact as follows:

Short title: This By-law may be cited as, "Village of Chase Zoning Amendment By-law No. 70, 1972".

Definition: "Natural Boundary - means the visible high water mark of any lake, river, stream or other body of water where the presence and action of the water are so common and usual and so long continued in all ordinary years as to mark upon the soil of the body of the lake, river, stream or other body of water a character distinct from that of the banks thereof in respect to vegetation as well as in respect to the nature of the soil itself ".

3. Prohibition:

(1) "No building or structure shall be constructed, re-constructed, altered, moved or extended closer than 100 feet from the bank of the stream and not lower in elevation than 5 feet above the high water mark of the stream in the immediate vicinity".

(2) The high water mark along the creek shall be established by the owner to the satisfaction of the Village of Chase Council. These high water marks will then establish a longitudinal high water profile of the creek, which profile must have a continuous downstream slope. A line parallel to the so established high water profile and five feet higher in elevation will then give land elevations which would be the lower limit for building construction.

4. The zoning classification of all of Lot B, Plan 2840, D.L. 517 except Plans 8376, 9836, 10368, 12639, 16029, 16303 and 17489, as shown outlined in red on the attached plan, is hereby changed from Al Rural to Rl Residential.
