

VILLAGE OF CHASE

BY-LAW NO. 110

A By-Law to authorize the borrowing
of the estimated cost of construction
of a new Fire Hall in Chase, B.C.

~~WHEREAS it is provided by Section 213 of the Municipal Act
that the Municipal Council may, by By-law, make provision for
obtaining at the time of the annual election, the opinion of the
Municipal electors upon any question which affects the Municipality
and with which the Municipal Council has power to deal;~~

~~AND~~ WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient to construct
a Fire Hall to service the Village of Chase;

AND WHEREAS the estimated cost of construction of said Fire
Hall, including expenses incidental thereto, is the sum of Sixty-six
Thousand One Hundred and Twenty-five Dollars (\$66,125.00).

AND WHEREAS the amount of the assessed value for general
Municipal purposes of the taxable land and improvements for the
current year and for each of the two years immediately preceding
the current year were:

Year 1972	\$2,601,332.00
Year 1973	\$2,918,623.00
Year 1974	\$4,057,123.00

AND WHEREAS the amount of the authorized debenture debt of
the Village of Chase is \$119,200.00, of which \$119,200.00 is
existing outstanding debenture debt and \$ NIL is
authorized and unissued debenture debt, and none of the principal
or interest of the debenture debt of the Village of Chase is in
arrears;

AND WHEREAS the maximum term for which debentures may be
issued to secure the debt created by this By-law is Twenty
(20) years;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Chase, in open
meeting assembled, enacts as follows:-

1. The Council is hereby empowered and authorized to undertake
and carry out or cause to be carried out the construction
of a Fire Hall generally in accordance with general plans
approved by the local Building Inspector, and to do all
things necessary in connection therewith and without limiting
the generality of the foregoing --
 - (1) To borrow upon the credit of the Municipality a sum not
exceeding \$ 49,000.00 .

(2) To acquire all such real property, easements, rights-of-way, licences, rights or authorities as may be requisite or desirable for or in connection with the construction of the said Fire Hall.

2. This By-law may be cited as "Village of Chase Fire Hall Loan Authorization By-law No. 110, 1974".
