

VILLAGE OF CHASE

BY-LAW NO. 161

A By-Law of the Village of Chase to amend Schedule "A", By-Law No. 13, respecting licences for carrying on a business within the Village of Chase and for fixing the fees for such licences.

The Council of the Village of Chase, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-Law No. 13, "Business Licence By-Law, 1969," is hereby amended by making the following additions to Schedule "A".
 - (a) From every person keeping a Bowling Alley for hire or profit, Two Dollars and Fifty Cents for each alley or runway for every six months.
 - (b) From every person keeping game machines for hire or profit, Five Dollars for each machine for every six months.
 - (c) From every owner of any automatic vending machine for sale of confectionery, tobacco and soft drinks, Ten Dollars for every six months for each machine.
 - (d) For every person operating a profession, business, trade, occupation, employment, not hereinbefore included in Schedule "A", Ten Dollars for every six months.

~~2. The amended Schedule of Rates enacted herein shall take effect on September 1st, 1977. WA~~

3. This By-Law may be cited for all purposes as "Village of Chase Business Licence Amendment By-Law No. 161, 1977."
