

VILLAGE OF CHASE

BY-LAW NO. 163

A By-Law to authorize the acquisition by purchase of certain real property for Municipal purposes, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Act and all amendments thereto.

The Council of The Village of Chase in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. It shall be lawful and the Council of the Village of Chase is hereby authorized to acquire by purchase from:

Crown Dominion
~~Parliament Buildings~~
~~Victoria, B. C.~~

the lands located within the Village boundaries of the Village of Chase and in the Province of British Columbia, and more particularly known and described as:

Lot 14, Block "U", Kamloops
Division Yale District, Plan 794
District Lot 517

containing 2318 square feet more or less and as shown outlined in "red" on the plan attached hereto and forming part of this By-Law, for purposes of "Municipal Use" at and for the total consideration of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

2. The said Council may improve and develop the said property for Municipal purposes.

3. The Mayor and Clerk of The Village of Chase be empowered and authorized to do all things necessary to give effect to the matters herein set out.

4. This By-Law may be cited for all purposes as "Land Acquisition By-Law No. 163, 1977."
