

VILLAGE OF CHASE

By-law No. 169

The Council of the Village of Chase in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

- (a) Water Extension By-law No. 32 is hereby repealed.
- (b) This By-law may be cited as "Village of Chase Water Utility Extension By-law No. 169, 1978."

1. Where an application for a water connection has been made and the connection cannot be provided unless a water main is extended, such extensions shall be made on the following conditions:

- (a) Such applicant shall provide and install such extensions at his own expense, provided that within a five (5) year period following completion of the extension, as each subsequent water connection is made to each parcel of land, which fronts or abuts on the street, highway or other right-of-way, or which such water extension is constructed and which lies between the existing mains and the nearest boundary of the applicant's property, the applicant shall be rebated an amount equal to: The quotient of the front footage of the parcel connected divided by the number of feet paid for by the applicant, multiplied by the original cost of the extension.

The total amount rebated to the applicant shall not either singly nor in aggregate, exceed 50% of the original amount expended by him.

Each applicant applying for a connection to such extensions within five (5) years of completion of the extension, shall pay to the Village a sum equal to the water connection fees as set out by the Village at the time, together with the amount as specified by the Village for his portion of the extension, the latter to be applied against the rebates to the subdivider who installed the extension as described above.

2. Every extension and every distribution main and all other works carried out under this by-law shall be in accordance with Village specifications and shall be under the supervision of the Village Engineer, and due notice shall be given to the Village Clerk before any work in connection with extending such water main is commenced.

3. This By-law may be cited as "Village of Chase Water Utility Extension By-law No. 169, 1978."
