

VILLAGE OF CHASE

REPEALING BY-LAW NO. 177

A By-law to Repeal By-law No. 148, 1976, which authorized the borrowing of money for the purpose of altering and renovating the Chase Community Hall.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 244 of the Municipal Act, Council may repeal By-law No. 148, which authorized the Council of the Village of Chase to borrow the sum of \$14,000.00 for the purpose of carrying out major alterations and renovations to the Chase Community Hall.

AND WHEREAS, this borrowing authority was never exercised by the Village of Chase.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of the Village of Chase, in Open Meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

That Borrowing By-law No. 148, 1976, is hereby repealed as the By-law was not proceeded with.

This By-law may be cited as "Village of Chase Repealing By-law No. 177, 1978."

READ A THIRD TIME this 8th day of JUNE, 1978.
