## VILLAGE OF CHASE

## BY-LAW NO. 189

WHEREAS the Council may, under the provisions of Section 200 of the "Municipal Act", provide for the paying out of the annual revenue an annual indemnity to the Mayor and Aldermen.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Chase in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That By-law No. 153, "Council Indemnity By-law" is hereby repealed.
- 2. Annual Indemnity.
  - (a) There shall be paid out of the annual revenue, an annual indemnity to the Mayor in the amount of \$2,415.00, and to each Alderman \$1,575.00.
  - (b) Each of the indemnities shall be paid in equal quarterly installments.
  - (c) One Third of the remuneration paid to the Mayor and the Aldermen shall be paid as an allowance for expenses incident to the discharge of the duties of his office.

Mayor - One Third Expense Allowance \$805.00.

Aldermen - One Third Expense Allowance \$525.00.

3. This By-law may be cited as the "Council Indemnity By-law No. 189."
