## VILLAGE OF CHASE

## BY-LAW NO. 223

A By-law to Authorize the Disposal of Certain Real Property Pursuant to Section 536 of the Municipal Act

The Council of the Village of Chase in Open Meeting Assembled, Enacts as Follows:

1. It shall be lawful and the Council of the Village of Chase is hereby authorized to dispose of by sale, lands located within the Village boundaries of the Village of Chase and in the Province of British Columbia, and more particularly known and described as:

That part of Lot "A", District Lot 517, Kamloops Division Yale District, Plan 5647, which lies to the North of the Northerly boundary of Plan "A"973 as shown on Plan 5647, Village of Chase and Kamloops Assessment Area.

containing 2500 square feet more or less and as shown outlined in "red" on the plan attached hereto and forming part of this By-law.

- 2. Reason for disposal of the above described land is that it be utilized as road right-of-way in conjunction with development of the adjacent Lot 6, Plan 1467. Any excess of said Lot "A" not utilized as road right-of-way may be consolidated into proposed development of Lot 6, Plan 1467.
- 3. Sale of said land is for a firm price of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).
- 4. The Mayor and Clerk of the Village of Chase be hereby empowered and authorized to do all things necessary to give effect to the matters herein set out.
- 5. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Village of Chase Land Disposal By-law No. 223, 1981."
