Deputy Inspector of Municipalities

A By-law to provide For the Imposition of a Charge Against The Owner Or Occupier of Real Property For the Use of The Sanitary Sewerage System Of the Village of Chase

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Chase is hereby empowered by the Municipal Act to impose and levy a charge against the owner or occupier of real property for the use of the Sanitary Sewerage System.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Chase, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (a) The several rates enumerated in Schedule "A" annexed hereto, which said schedule is hereby incorporated herewith and made a part of this by-law, are hereby imposed and shall be charged, levied and collected by the Village of Chase for service provided to any premises within the limits of the Village, and shall be paid to the Collector of the Village by the owner or occupier of land or real property which is connected to the sanitary sewer system.
- (b) The rates set out in Schedule "A" shall be billed annually in advance, and shall be due and payable on the 31st day of July in each year.
- (c) The rates set out in Schedule "A" may be paid annually in advance, and the Collector shall allow a discount of five (5) percentum on annual prepayments made on or before the first Friday in March for the then current calendar year.
- In the case of new applications for service, or application for resumption of service, the applicant shall be allowed a reduction or rebate for the then current year appropriate to the part of such year which has expired at the date of application.
- Any charges authorized by this by-law, which remain unpaid by December 31st in the year in which they were imposed, shall form a charge or lien upon the land or real property upon or in respect of which the same is imposed, and the provisions of Section 435 of the Municipal Act shall apply to the collection of such charges.
- In the case of Seasonal or part-time users, the user may be allowed to prorate the fee for the months the utility is used.
- 5. This by-law may be cited as "Village of Chase Sewer User Rates By-law No. 255, 1982."
