

VILLAGE OF CHASE

BY-LAW NO. 346

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR AN ANNUAL INDEMNITY
AND EXPENSES TO MEMBERS OF COUNCIL

WHEREAS the Council may, under the provisions of Section 267 of the Municipal Act, provide for the paying out of annual revenue an annual indemnity to the Mayor and Aldermen, and

WHEREAS the Income Tax Act requires remuneration and expenses to be defined,

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Village of Chase, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as "Council Indemnity Bylaw No. 346, 1987.
2. The individual who is the Mayor will receive from general revenue a remuneration of Two Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$2,400.00) per annum, and an expense allowance of One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00) per annum.
3. The individual who is an Alderman will receive from general revenue a remuneration of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) per annum, and an expense allowance of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per annum.
4. The remuneration and expense allowance shall be paid quarterly, in equal installments.

6. Bylaw No. 242, cited as "Council Indemnity Bylaw 242, 1982" is hereby repealed.

7. That this Bylaw comes in force and effect upon the adoption thereof.






