READ A FIRST TIME THIS 11th day of August, 1988.

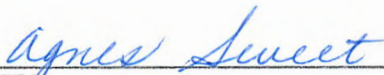
READ A SECOND TIME THIS 11th day of August, 1988.

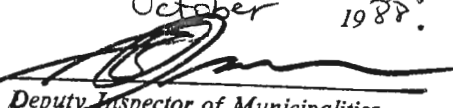
