

VILLAGE OF CHASE

BYLAW NO. 421

A Bylaw of the Village of Chase for the holding of an Advanced Poll at all elections in the Village of Chase, including submissions to the electors.

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Chase deems it desirable to provide for the holding of an advanced poll at all the elections, including submissions to the electors, at the Municipal Hall.

The Council of the Village of Chase, in open meeting assembled,  
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Bylaw No. 392 is hereby repealed.

2. An advance poll shall be opened by the Returning Officer at the Municipal Hall and kept open between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on the Thursday and 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the Friday two weeks prior to polling day, if the polling day falls on a weekday, and one week prior to polling day if the polling day falls on a Saturday.

3. Only those persons who, being duly qualified electors, sign a statement that:

- a) They expect to be absent from the Village of Chase on polling day,
- b) They are, for reasons of conscience, prevented from voting on polling day,
- c) Through circumstances beyond their control, they will not be able to attend the poll on polling day,

shall be allowed to vote at an advance poll.

4. A notice shall be issued pursuant to Section 92 of the Municipal Act, stating clearly the days and hours on which the advance poll will be opened to those electors mentioned in Section 2 herein, in addition to the days and hours which the poll be open for all other electors.

5. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Village of Chase Advance Poll Bylaw No. 421, 1991."
