

VILLAGE OF CHASE

BY-LAW NO. 474

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR AN ANNUAL INDEMNITY
AND EXPENSES TO MEMBERS OF COUNCIL

WHEREAS the Council may, under the provisions of Section 267 of the Municipal Act, provide for the paying out of annual revenue an annual indemnity to the Mayor and Councillors, and:

WHEREAS the Income Tax Act requires remuneration and expenses to be defined:

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Village of Chase, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as "Council Indemnity Bylaw No. 474, 1992".
2. The individual who is the Mayor will receive from general revenue a remuneration of the Three Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Three Dollars and Thirty Three Cents, (\$3,333.33) per annum, and an expense allowance of One Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Six Dollars and Sixty Seven Cents (\$1,666.67) per annum.
3. The individual who is a Councillor will receive from general revenue a remuneration of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) per annum and an expense allowance of One Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$1,250.00) per annum.
4. The remuneration and expense allowance shall be paid quarterly, in equal installments.
5. That this Bylaw will be implemented on December 1, 1992.
6. Bylaw No. 409, cited as "Council Indemnity Bylaw 409, 1990" will be repealed, on November 30, 1992.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 26th. day of November, 1992.

READ A THIRD TIME THIS 26th. day of November, 1992.


