

VILLAGE OF CHASE

BYLAW NO. 478

A Bylaw to amend Regulation of Traffic and Use of Streets in the Village of Chase.

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Chase have enacted Bylaw #17 cited as the "Street and Traffic Bylaw #17, 1970;

AND WHEREAS as it is deemed expedient to amend the said bylaw #17 to allow for canopies and awnings to project onto Public Streets;

NOW THEREFORE in open meeting assembled the Council of the Village of Chase, enacts as follows;

- 1) This bylaw may be cited as the "Street and Traffic Amendment Bylaw No. 478, 1992".
- 2) That Part 2 of Bylaw #17 be amended under section 65 - Regulatory Advertising Devices by adding the following category;

"Canopies and Awnings"

NO PERSON SHALL INSTALL A CANOPY OR AWNING OVER A PUBLIC SIDEWALK OR STREET UNLESS THEY HAVE RECEIVED A PERMIT FOR SAME.

READ A FIRST TIME this 10th. day of December, 1992.


READ A SECOND TIME this 10th. day of December, 1992.
