BYLAW NO. 530

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Being a Bylaw to amend the 1995 to 1999 Capital Expenditure Program.

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The Municipal Council of the Village of Chase, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Capital Expenditure Program Bylaw No. 524, 1995 be amended by deleting Schedule "A" in its entirety and that Schedule "A" attached hereto and made part of this Bylaw is hereby declared to be the Capital Expenditure Program of the Village of Chase for the years 1995 to 1999 inclusive.
