

VILLAGE OF CHASE

BYLAW NO. 599 - 2000

A BYLAW RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF A PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR
ADMINISTERING THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF
PRIVACY ACT

WHEREAS Section 77 of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, Chapter 165, R.S.B.C. 1996, and amendments thereto, empowers the Council to enact a bylaw to appoint a person or group of persons as the head of the local public body for the purposes of this Act;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Village of Chase deems it necessary to provide for the administration of this Act within the Village of Chase.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Village of Chase in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the Clerk be designated the head of the local public body for the purposes of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.
2. That the Village of Chase Administrative Fees Bylaw apply for the purpose of determining fees where the Act permits fees to be levied.
3. This bylaw may be cited as "Village of Chase Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Appointment and Fees Bylaw No. 599 - 2000."
