

# REMUNERATION AND EXPENSE BYLAW #610

#### **VILLAGE OF CHASE**

#### BYLAW NO. 610 - 2000

## A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR COUNCIL MEMBER REMUNERATION AND THE EXPENSES OF COUNCIL MEMBERS AND VILLAGE STAFF

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Village of Chase wishes to provide for remuneration to Council members;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Village of Chase wishes to provide for the expenses incurred by Council members and Village staff during the execution of their duties;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Village of Chase in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

#### Part A - Remuneration to Council Members

- 1. a. The annual remuneration for the Mayor for the discharge of the duties of office is \$9,600.00.
  - b. The annual remuneration for a Councillor for the discharge of the duties of the office is \$6,000.00.
  - c. In addition to the amount set out in section 1(b), the remuneration for the Deputy Mayor appointed by resolution of the Council, is \$100.00 for each three month period.
  - d. One third of the annual sum paid in 1(a) and (b) represents an allowance for expenses.

#### Part B - Expenses Incurred by Council Members and Village Staff

- 2. a. Claims for the reimbursement of expenditures or expenses incurred by a Council member or Village staff member shall be provided in writing to the Treasurer with the associated proof of purchase or receipt whenever possible.
  - b. Claims for the reimbursement of expenditures or expenses incurred shall only be paid where the expenditure or expense incurred has been authorized or is incidental to the routine execution of a Council member's or Village staff member's duties.

- c. Where such a claim fulfils the requirements of this bylaw, the Treasurer shall promptly pay said claim.
- 3. Expenditures or expenses incurred shall be eligible for reimbursement when the Council member or Village staff member is:
  - ➤ representing the Village;
  - ➤ engaging in Village business; or,
  - > attending a meeting, course or convention on behalf of the Village.
- 4. a. A Council member or Village staff member may elect to receive reimbursement for the cost of meals incurred under section 3 by one of the following two options:
  - i. a \$50 daily allowance where duties under section 3 encompass one or more twenty-four hour days; or,
  - ii. on an individual meal basis, where duties under section 3 do not exceed twenty-four hours, in accordance with the following:
    - ➤ breakfast \$10.00;
    - ➤ lunch \$15.00; and,
    - ➤ dinner \$25.00.
  - b. Where a meal or meals are provided at the meeting, course or convention, the daily allowance is reduced by the amount specified in section 4(a)(ii) for the specified meals provided.
  - c. Where a Council member or Village staff member provides transportation for duties under section 3 through the use of their personal motor vehicle, reimbursement shall be at the rate of \$0.39 per kilometre.
- 5. The types of expenditures and expense that may qualify for reimbursement are:
  - ➤ accommodation;
  - ➤ transportation including parking fees, highway tolls and ferries;
  - > meals, gratuities and non-alcoholic beverages; and,
  - telephone, facsimile, photocopying and other office-related functions.

### Part C - Repeal

6. Village of Chase Council Remuneration and Expenses Bylaw No. 556, 1996 is hereby repealed.

#### Part D - Citation

7. This bylaw may be cited as the "Village of Chase Remuneration and Expense Bylaw No. 610 - 2000."
