BYLAW NO. 625, 2001

**A BYLAW TO AMEND THE VILLAGE OF CHASE HIGHWAY, TRAFFIC
AND PARKING REGULATION BYLAW NO. 482, 1993**

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Village of Chase has adopted the Village of Chase Highway, Traffic and Parking Regulation Bylaw No. 482, 1993;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Village of Chase deems it necessary to amend Bylaw No. 482;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Village of Chase in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the following section be added to Section 3 GENERAL PROHIBITIONS:
 3. (g) The person in immediate charge and control of a horse when off the lands or premises of the owner shall not permit or allow the horse to be on a sidewalk.
 3. (h) No person shall ride, push, coast upon or otherwise propel or use a skateboard or push scooter on a sidewalk between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. in the following blocks:
 - 500 Shuswap Avenue;
 - 600 Shuswap Avenue;
 - 700 Shuswap Avenue; and,
 - 800 Shuswap Avenue;
3. This bylaw may be cited as "Village of Chase Highway, Traffic and Parking Regulation Bylaw No. 482 Amendment Bylaw No. 625, 2001."
