## **BYLAW NO. 676 - 2006**

## A BYLAW TO CLOSE UP A PORTION OF HIGHWAY

**WHEREAS** under the Community Charter a Council may close a highway to traffic;

**AND WHEREAS** the Municipal Council of the Village of Chase deems it expedient to provide for a closure of a portion of highway;

**AND WHEREAS** the Municipal Council of the Village of Chase has posted and published notices of its intention to close that portion of the highway referred to in this Bylaw and has provided an opportunity for persons who consider they are affected to make representations to Council;

**AND WHEREAS** the Municipal Council of the Village of Chase does not consider that the closure will affect the transmission or distribution facilities or works of utility operators;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Village of Chase in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. The section of the unnamed lane in the 500 block between First Avenue and Shuswap Avenue from Pine Street to Chase Creek as delineated in bold on Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this Bylaw, are hereby closed permanently.
- 2. Council hereby authorizes the closure to all types of traffic of that portion of highway dedicated by plan 514.
- 3. The Mayor and Corporate Administrator are hereby authorized to execute all plans and other instruments as are necessary to effect the aforesaid closure of the highway.
- 4. This bylaw may be cited as "Village of Chase Highway Closure Bylaw No. 676 2006."
