BYLAW NO. 682 - 2006

A BYLAW TO AMEND THE VILLAGE OF CHASE FIRE REGULATIONS BYLAW NO. 550 - 1996

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Village of Chase has adopted the Village of Chase Fire Regulations Bylaw No. 550, 1996;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Village of Chase deems it necessary to amend Bylaw No. 550;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Chase in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Fire Regulations Bylaw No. 550, 1996 is hereby amended as follows:

By deleting in its entirety Sections 2 (a) (i), (iii) and (iv) and replacing with the following:

- 2 (a)
- (i) It shall be unlawful for any person at any time within the limits of the Village, to light or start, or knowingly permit, or cause to start or ignite any fire of any kind whatsoever in the open air, including backyard fire pits, without first obtaining a Burning Permit from the Village Clerk.
- (iii) For backyard fire pits, a Burning Permit shall be issued and shall remain valid for the calendar year in which it is issued. For all other burning a Burning Permit shall be issued for any number of days needed but will not exceed a maximum of fourteen (14) days. A Burning Permit may be renewed for subsequent periods. A Burning Permit expires automatically if not renewed and becomes void at any time a prohibition on open burning is declared by the Provincial Government.
- (iv) A non-refundable fee of \$10.00 is payable prior to the issuance of each Burning Permit. This fee is also payable upon renewal of a Burning Permit.

By deleting in its entirety Section 3 and replacing with the following:

3 Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2 (a) (i), it shall be unlawful for any person at any time, within the limits of the Village, to light or start a fire for the purpose of landclearing, demolishing a building or materials therefrom or open field burning. For the burning of common household or garden refuse a person must first obtain a Burning Permit from the Village Clerk.

By deleting in its entirety Schedule "A" and replacing with the attached Schedule "A."

2. This bylaw may be cited as "Village of Chase Fire Regulations Bylaw No. 550, 1996, Amendment Bylaw No. 682 - 2006."

- A \$10 non-refundable fee is payable prior to the issuance of a permit;
- Permits for backyard fire pits are valid for the calendar year in which they are issued and expire on December 31st; permits for controlled burning are valid for fourteen (14) days and expire automatically;
- This permit and permission to burn may at any time be cancelled or suspended by the local authority;
- This permit is void at any time the Provincial Government prohibits open burning:
- The permit holder shall be liable for all damages caused by a fire set under this
 permit and may be liable for all costs of extinguishing any resulting fires for
 failure to comply with permit conditions or orders of the Fire Chief or his
 designate;
- No burning is permitted during windy conditions
- No fire shall be allowed to create excessive amounts of smoke so as to disturb or interfere with residents of the vicinity;
- All burning must be attended by adult supervision with the necessary firefighting equipment available;

 No burning is to occur near standing timber, bush, buildings or flammable material; All fires must be extinguished prior to leaving the burning area; and, Other special conditions:
