Another concern I have is water meters. Why does the Village rely so much on the money colleted from water meters? The amount that is actually collected is inconsistant, compared to relying on the Basic Water and Sever sports

for the 'lien's share' your mong raised. 2 people, 30% is one person, 45% are 2 person, the rest are 3 or more person households. Of the 75% of households, almost all of them are 65 years of age or older. So for, January, February and March, 75% of the households of chase, used 30 cubic meters of water or less and were charged 60 cubic moters of water. This works out to an average overcharge of \$55 per household.
