VILLAGE OF CHASE BYLAW NO. 736 - 2010

MUNCIPAL TICKET INFORMATION BYLAW

A Bylaw to implement a Municipal Ticketing System

(CONSOLIDATED FOR CONVENIENCE ONLY, INCLUDING BASE 736, AMENDMENTS 830, 835, 898, 908, 909, 918)

WHEREAS the *Community Charter* authorizes Council, by bylaw, to designate those Village bylaws which may be enforced by means of a municipal ticketing system; which offences are subject to municipal ticketing; who can issue municipal tickets and what fines may be imposed for each offence.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Chase, in the Province of British Columbia, hereby **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "MUNICIPAL TICKET INFORMATION BYLAW NO. 736 2010".
- 2. The bylaws, as amended or replaced from time to time, listed in Column 1 of Schedule A of this bylaw may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed in Section 273 of the *Community Charter*.
- 3. In Schedule A of this bylaw, the persons appointed to the job positions or titles listed in Column 2 are designated as Bylaw Enforcement Officers under Section 264 of the *Community Charter* for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1.
- 4. In Appendices 1 through 11 of this bylaw, the words or expressions in Column 1 designate the offence committed under the bylaw section number appearing in Column 2.
- 5. In Appendices 1 through 11 of this bylaw, the amounts appearing in Column 3 are the fines set under Section 265 of the *Community Charter* for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1.
- 6. If any portion of this Bylaw is held to be invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity does not affect the remaining portions of the Bylaw.
